### Parks and Events Minutes July 20, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Susan Dolan. Visitors were introduced.

The minutes of the June 16, 2009 meeting were approved.

Kim Fitzgerald and the committee discussed the Family Fun Day event on 7/18/09. There were many comments about the success of the event and notes were made about a few items to improve for next year. It was agreed that planning for the event should be started earlier since many of the sponsors budget their funds in the fall for the entire year. A final accounting of expenditures and revenue will be done in the next few days so the final net profit can be determined.

Chris True reported that although the new tetherball seems to be very popular and well used, it has also attracted vandals and the ball has been stolen 3 times since it was installed in the spring. After a discussion, it was agreed that the committee would authorize Ron to purchase 2-4 more tetherballs (up to \$100) from the recreational equipment budget line, but Chris will first do research to see if there might be equipment available that would offer a higher degree of security. Once installed, if additional thefts occur, it was suggested that replacement be delayed.

Discussion of a volleyball court was tabled.

Ivy Wells mentioned that she will be unable to work the concession shack on Aug 1st & 9th for the Shakespeare in the Park event and will contact some volunteers.

Billy Shifflett reported that the most urgent repairs have been done at the parks and the shed has been closed and secured.

Cole Holocker will be submitting the paperwork to receive credit for the service hours he has worked on the P&E committee.

It was clarified that officially, pets are not allowed at town events.

It was discussed and decided that Chris True will ask the Council to reallocate the budget line "Movies in the Park" \$600 to Parks & Events "Advertising".

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
